

What work is being carried out?

The railway line at Hinksey has suffered from flooding for several years. This causes widespread disruption when it forces the line to be closed between Didcot and Oxford.

Network Rail, in partnership with the Environment Agency, will be carrying out major work along a 400 metre long section of track. This will involve significantly raising the level of the running lines.

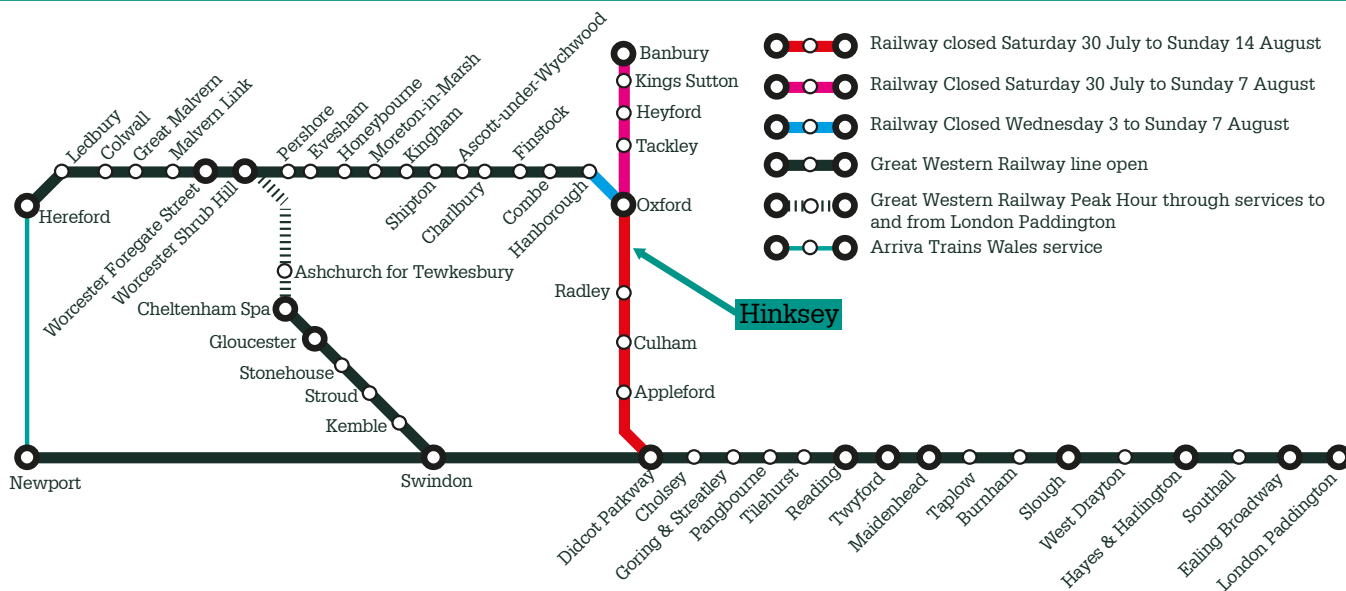
There will also be a culvert installed under the railway, on the north section opposite the caravan site. This will allow water to flow under the line from west to east, which will relegate the water levels.

This work is part of the wider flood prevention scheme which is being carried out to protect homes to the south of Oxford.

From Saturday 30 July to Sunday 14 August 2016 the railway will be closed between Oxford and Didcot Parkway to enable Network Rail to carry out flood prevention work in the Hinksey area.

In addition to this, from Saturday 30 July to Sunday 7 August 2016 the railway will be closed between Oxford and Banbury for re-signalling work.

Then, from Wednesday 3 to Sunday 7 August 2016 the railway will be closed between Oxford and Hanborough for bridge repair work to take place.

Travelling south of Oxford:

Our South Wales, Bristol and Cheltenham Spa High Speed services will continue to call at Didcot Parkway.

In addition we will operate:

- A semi-fast service each hour between London Paddington and Didcot Parkway calling at Slough and Reading
- Two services each hour calling at selected stations between London Paddington and Didcot Parkway

Travelling north of Oxford we will operate:

- One service an hour between Oxford and Worcester Foregate Street, with connecting London Midland services to Hereford
- Peak hour trains in both directions between London Paddington and Worcester will be diverted via Cheltenham Spa
